■ Objective

The 18th Girl Scout International e-Camp, 2021 has the aim of providing Girl Scouts/Guides and Scouts with opportunities:

- to enhance world citizenship by interacting with participants who have diverse backgrounds, sharing international friendship.
- to create a safe and comfortable online environment for girls and young women struggling with international exchanges due to movement restrictions.

■ Date

August 1 – August 20, 2021 (20 days and around the clock)

■ Platform

The 18th Girl Scout International e-Camp will take place online.

■ Theme

Apart and Together! – Making endless possibility through opportunity and challenge.

■ Language

The official language of the e-Camp is Korean and English.

■ Camp Emblem



- The emblem introduce The 18th Girl Scout International e-Camp, Korea will be held online. Wi-Fi represent networks and connection for international exchanges.
- The emblem also represent a meeting in virtual camping and The DMZ symbol means delivering a message of peace through South Korea, the only divided country.

- Celebrated performance of MOs
